SURVEILLANCE & FACIAL RECOGNITION - NOTICE TO MEMBERS

Facial Recognition is deployed throughout the Club's property. This is used specifically for the safety and security of all members, patrons, staff and other visitors to our site.

This is for the very specific purpose of preventing entry into the club by individuals for whom entry is not permitted.

The facial recognition technology does not retain facial images but the digital representation or signature of the face. These digital signatures can only be used for matching purposes and faces of individuals cannot be recreated or constructed from them.

The digital face signatures are matched against a persons of interest database which also contains only digital signatures. If there is a match our staff will take appropriate action.

The persons of interest are those for who are excluded from entry to the cub or the defined areas of the club. These persons of interest are limited to:

- Those who have committed to a self-exclusion program (i.e. Venue based, Gaming area, TAB area).
- Those who have been suspended or banned by the club disciplinary procedures as per the club's constitution.
- Those who have been suspended from the venue through the local Armidale Liquor Accord "Barred from One Barred From All" program.

The only facial digital signatures retained are those matching one of digital signatures in the persons of interest database. All other captured facial digital signatures are immediately deleted without the possibility of recovery.
